

Universal Control 3.4.2 BETA Readme

Thank you for participating in the Universal Control 3.4.2 BETA for Snow Leopard. This BETA is only for Macintosh users who are running OSX 10.6 Snow Leopard. As this release does not add any new features to the release version 3.4.1, it is highly recommended that Macintosh users running 10.4.11 Tiger or 10.5 Leopard continue to use the current release driver available at the main PreSonus website.

This BETA is for the following products only: FireStudio Mobile, FireStudio Project, FireStudio Tube, FireStudio [26x26], FireStudio Lightpipe, StudioLive 16.4.2

FirePod, FP10, FireBox, and Inspire owners do not need to install a driver. These devices are still class compliant under Snow Leopard.

This BETA driver is fully supported by PreSonus Technical Support; however, if you have a question or issue directly relating to the BETA Program please feel free to contact BETAprogram@presonus.com

If you already have version 3.4.1 installed on your Snow Leopard machine, please uninstall it first by deleting the following files:

/Applications/Universal Control
MacHD/Library/Audio/MIDI Drivers/PAEFireStudioMIDIdriver.plugin
MacHD/Library/Receipts/PreSonus Universal Control.pkg
MacHD/System/Library/Extensions/PaeFireStudio.kext
USER/Library/PreSonus FOLDER

After you have deleted these files and emptied the trash, reboot your computer.

Please Note: the current 3.4.2 installer will not overwrite the 3.4.1 driver, you must delete these files prior to running the 3.4.2 installer to ensure proper operation.

Known issue:

- The 3.4.2 installer requires a manual restart following the installation. After you have run the installer, reboot your Mac before attempting to sync your FireStudio family device. Your FireStudio family device will not sync to your computer until it has been rebooted.
